

Prescribed Fire Public Information Fact Sheet



- Project Name: Caribou Rock
- Information Contact: Gunflint Ranger District, 218-387-1750
- Date of Burn: Spring or Fall
- Location: Up the Gunflint Trail, approximately 30 miles in the Midtrail Area. Off the Hungry Jack Road.
- Project Size: 265 Acres
- Project Description: The purpose is to reduce hazardous fuels. It is in a blowdown area. The unit has light to moderate blowdown within it. A low intensity fire is targeted due to the overstory pine in the area. Low intensity fire will minimize mortality to the pine.
- Public Safety: The Caribou Rock Trail will be closed. It will be reopened when it is determined safe for public travel. The portages between West Bearskin and Duncan Lake, Hungry Jack and Moss, and Moss and Duncan will remain open unless deemed unsafe for public access.
